


Arrival

The venue can be reached easily and quickly from Karlsruhe Central Station (Hauptbahnhof). Take tramline S1/S11 (Neureut or Hochstetten), tramline 6 (Daxlanden or Rappenwörth) or tramline 2 (ZKM – Siemensallee). You arrive without changing at the station “Mühlburger Tor”. From there it is a 1-minute-walk to the venue.

Please note that the Karlsruhe infrastructure of public transport is currently being heavily restructured. This may lead to short-term changes of the roadmap. Updated timetables are available on www.kvv.de.

Parking

Since the venue is near the city center of Karlsruhe, free car parking spaces are limited and usually occupied. However a parking garage is located directly at the venue (parking garage “Magdeburger Haus”, Kaiserallee 11, 76133 Karlsruhe) (opening hours: Monday - Saturday, 7.00 am - midnight). Another parking garage near the venue is located at “Ludwigsplatz” (drive: Amalienstraße 10, 76133 Karlsruhe) (open all hours). From there it is a 7-8-minute-walk to the conference venue.


The conference dinner will take place at Gastdozentenhaus „Heinrich Hertz“. The Gastdozentenhaus “Heinrich Hertz” (house for guest lecturers) is situated in the Northwest of the university grounds, near the castle and the Hardtwald forest, and still not far away from the center of the city.

The dinner includes a buffet and a welcome-drink. Other beverages are not included with dinner. The buffet will provide vegetarian options. If you have allergies or food intolerances that should be taken into account, please let me know no later than November 16, 2013.

Arrival

Gastdozentenhaus “Heinrich Hertz” can be reached easily and quickly from the conference venue (suburban train stop “Mühlburger Tor”). Take tramline S1/S11 (Ettlingen or Bad Herrenalb), tramline S5 (Söllingen, Berghausen or Pforzheim) or tramline S2 (Blankenloch, Spöck or Reitschulschlag). You arrive without changing at the station “Marktplatz”. From there it is a 10-minute-walk to Gastdozentenhaus “Heinrich Hertz”. Since the Karlsruhe infrastructure of public transport is being heavily restructured, the suburban train stop “Kronenplatz”, which is closer to the Gastdozentenhaus, is currently not approached. Please check updated timetables on the website of the Karlsruhe Transport Association (www.kvv.de).

Taxi transfers to the Gastdozentenhaus “Heinrich Hertz” can also be arranged. If needed, please contact a conference assistant in time.
